There are so many styles, designs and prices of or outside cameras it would bee impossible to designate one style or even a couple in different price ranges. Therefore we have decided on things that people could NOT do to keep it within a reasonable request.

- 1. Cameras cannot be aimed at neighbors homes.
- 2. No tracking motion they get stuck and don't always reset.
- 3. No flood lights
- 4. No cords can show on outside of building need to be behind siding.
- 5. No colors other than BLACK or BROWN
- 6. Doorbell rings are OK
- 7. Cameras in your own courtyards are OK as long as they are Only aimed at your private area.
- 8. Only mounted on your individual unit/garage. Specifically on your side of wall or fence. Not on fence between homes.
- 9. Not allowed on decks

An ACC request for outside cameras must be submitted to the ACC Committee for approval and proper placement on home/garage, prior to any installation. ONLY Doorbell ring cameras are allowed without approval.
